Pool:

The pool opens for the 2014 season on Saturday, May 3rd.

Swim Lessons:

We are looking to organize group swim lessons for anyone in the community who is interested. If you are interested, **please visit:**

Costs of the lessons will depend of the number of people truly interested. The cost per set of swim lessons will likely range between \$20 and \$35 per



person. Once we have a more reliable number, we will notify every of the exact cost and provide actual sign-up instructions. If you don't let us know you are interested, you will not be notified when the time comes.

Each set of swim lessons will include eight (8) 30 min or 45 min sessions. We are still working out the length of each session. The lessons will be held in the afternoons, Monday through Thursday (4 days a week) from around 4pm at the earliest to 8pm at the latest, but somewhere in that time frame. The time frame listed here was based on the feedback received from our residents.

We will likely hold swim lessons from June 9th through July 3rd, which is basically 2 sets of swim lessons (2 weeks each set). The reason for this is to allow the swimmers to start at one level for the first set of lessons, then as they begin to learn to swim, they can sign up for the 2nd set of lessons and move up to the next level. Based on the level of participation and interest, it is possible to add a 3rd set, but we will just have to wait and see how it plays out.

Who can sign up for swim lessons?

Any and all residents of The Club at Wells Point Community. If you have a close friend or relative that does not live here who is interested in signing up for swim lessons, they may sign up as long as a resident of this community is signing them up and is with them at all times while they are at the pool and as long as the resident does not exceed their guest limit of 2 guest per household.
